



## **Julian Nott** **Writer Member**

Julian Nott is a media composer who is best known for writing the music for the Wallace and Gromit films, the last of which - *A Matter of Loaf and Death* - earned him last year's TV Ivor Novello Award. However, any PRS members with kids under five years old may take the view that his music and songs for the extraordinarily popular pre-school *Peppa Pig* series has had an even greater impact.

Currently on TV, Julian's music can be heard on the BBC's Sunday night period costume drama *Lark Rise to Candleford*, the third series he has scored. Also on TV at the moment is this year's BAFTA winning Children's Best Animation Series *Ben and Holly's Little Kingdom*.

Julian has scored many TV and film productions over the last 15 years. He has provided the scores for six productions that have won or been nominated for Oscars and 12 for BAFTAs.

Julian came to film and TV fairly late. After university (a music scholar), he worked in investment banking in the City for three years and as a journalist on financial and City matters for The Economist Publications. After several years at the National Film and Television School, he made documentary films for Channel Four TV, Arte Channel in France and WGBM in Boston. As a drama film-maker, he received a producer BAFTA nomination and also earned himself a best newcomer nomination at the British Independent Film Awards as a feature film director. Along the way he also picked up a qualification as a (non-practising) barrister.
