Mark pursued a career as a professional musician at the age of 17, and with a group of fellow Jersey musicians went on to record 5 albums for major labels.

He was then offered the position of A&R Manager/Administrator at the newly formed Radar Records (a Warners company), and then joined Albion Music as General Manager. Mark then became a partner in Polar Union Ltd., a management and publishing company.

In 1992 he was approached by the independent publisher Bug Music in Los Angeles to open and head a newly formed company in London.

In 2001, he was first elected to the Board of the Music Publishers Association (MPA), and is actively involved in many aspects of the organisation including Pop Publishers Committee, and the Education and Training Group.

In 2006, Mark took on the additional role of President of International for the parent company that has offices in Los Angeles, London, Nashville, New York, Atlanta, Amsterdam and Munich, and a network of representatives globally. Following the purchase in 2007 of "Windswept Music", his role now also includes international responsibilities for that catalogue.

In July 2009, Mark became a director of MCPS.
