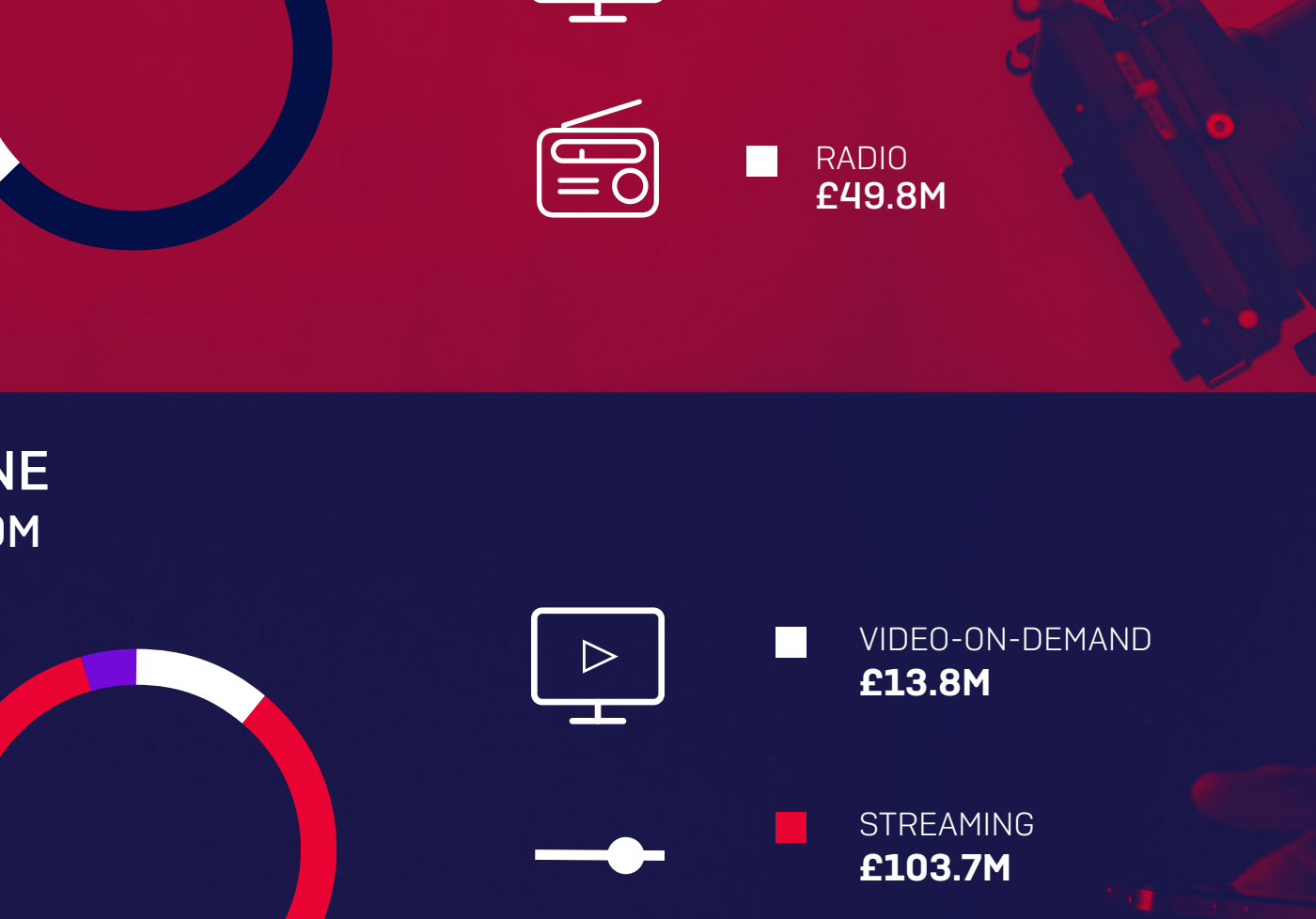

STRONG GROWTH ACROSS ALL REVENUE AREAS IN 2017



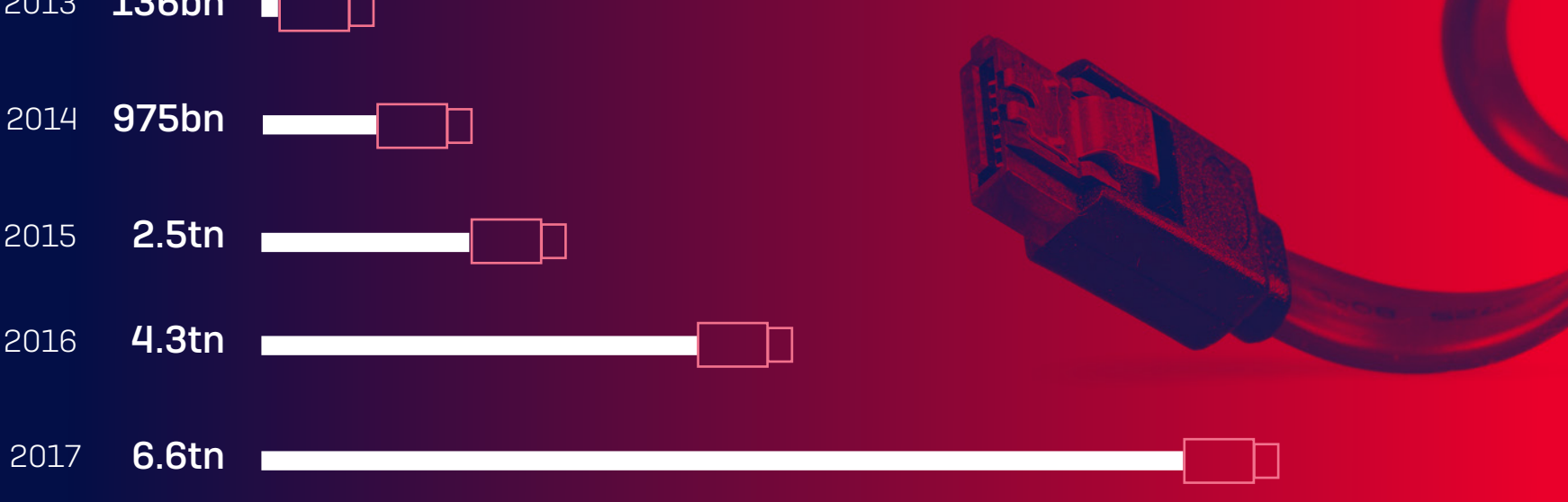

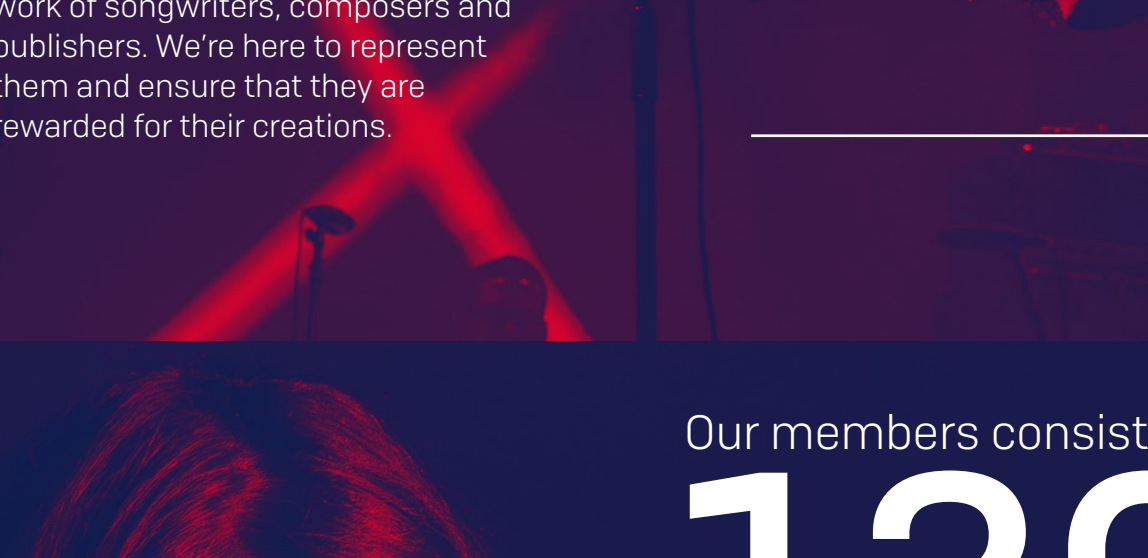

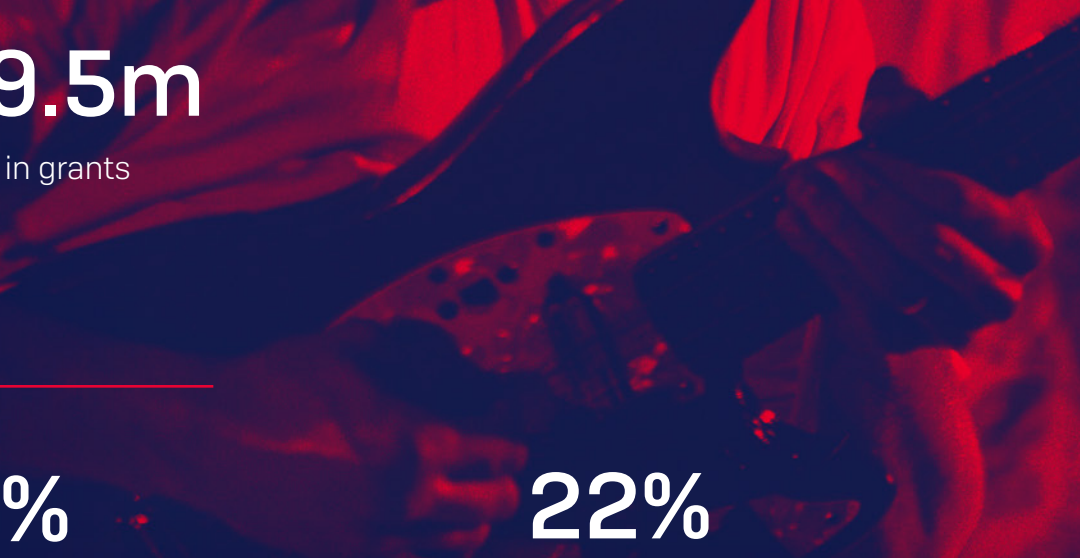

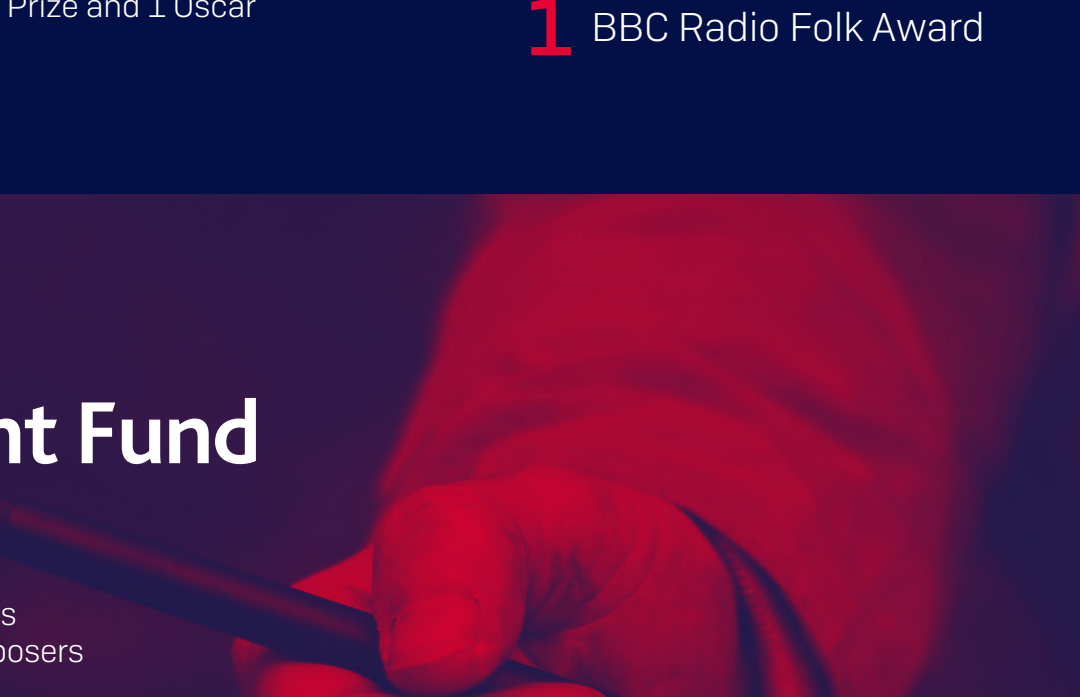

PRS Foundation supports a range of initiatives from international showcases, commissions, UK tours and festivals, to composer residencies & professional development.
