THIS TARIFF IS EFFECTIVE FROM 01-SEP-16 TO 31-AUG-17

In the context of a joint licence issued by PPL, acting on behalf of itself and PRS for Music, this tariff is subject to the PPL/PRS Joint Licence Terms for Nurseries, Playgroups, Pre-Schools & Crèches, a copy of which can be read on the PPL website or obtained by contacting PPL.

In the context of a licence issued directly by PPL this tariff is subject to PPL's "General Terms and Conditions for Public Performance Licences", a copy of which can be read on the PPL website or obtained by contacting PPL.

NOTES:

This tariff applies to the public performance of PPL's repertoire at nurseries, playgroups, pre-schools & crèches ("Nurseries"), whether run by a local authority or independently, as part of the activities of such establishment.

This tariff covers the use of music within your Nursery, including, but not limited to; extra-curricular dance & movement classes (for example; mummy & baby yoga), fetes & fairs, child minding services, breakfast/holiday clubs, parent evenings/open days, general background music and music on hold.

This tariff does not apply to:

- Uses of music at Nurseries which form part of schools whether wholly or partially government funded or independent ('private' and 'public'), to which other PPL tariffs specifically apply.
- Featured music at events, or in facilities, run by a party other than the Nursery or where any profit or benefit does not go entirely to the Nursery. This includes, but is not limited to, concerts, festivals, theatrical performances, dance and aerobic classes.
- Uses of music specified in section 34 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended

Surcharge

If you have been publicly performing sound recordings without first obtaining or renewing your licence, the fees below will be subject to a 50% surcharge. This is designed to act as a deterrent to unlicensed public performances of sound recordings, and to compensate PPL for the considerable administrative effort expended in detecting and taking action in respect of these infringements of copyright.

Flat Fee: £ 40 per annum.

VAT should be added at the current rate to the above charges.
